

Jean Monnet Network LAWTTIP - Legal Ambiguities withstanding TTIP



The LAWTTIP Network

Based on a consortium of 3 renowned European university centres, namely the International Research Centre on European Law of the University of Bologna (CIRDE), the Centre of European Law of the King's College London (CEL) and the Institut de l'Ouest Droit et Europe of the University of Rennes 1 (IODE), where leading EU-law scholars work together with talented academic in their early stages of career, the **Jean Monnet Network LAWTTIP – Legal Ambiguities withstanding TTIP** intends to promote a large-scale legal reflection of both the existing EU Free Trade Agreements of new generation and the ongoing negotiations on the Transatlantic Trade Investment Partnership (TTIP).



LAWTTIP's objectives

LAWTTIP and its activities have been designed to *foster exchange between academics involved in research and teaching on EU law, policymakers, stakeholders and EU citizens*, in order to:

- establish a common platform—starting from the project's major communication tool, that is, the LAWTTIP website (<http://www.lawttip.eu>)—to build a strong knowledge on the legal implications of the TTIP model from an EU perspective;
- adapt the existing research & teaching activities in EU legal studies to problems posed by the TTIP and other EU trade agreements of new generation;
- develop closer synergies, exchanges of best practices, the promotion and diffusion of innovative teaching methods and techniques, as well as the enhancement of the quality of the 3 partners' teaching programmes' offer;
- create a forum with EU/Member State policymakers and stakeholders for the elaboration of indicators, including benchmarks, to monitor the TTIP/EU trade talks and their impact on the EU legal order, as well as policy tools and recommendations to overcome the possible shortcomings;
- translate scientific and policy-relevant outcomes into publicly-understandable outputs.

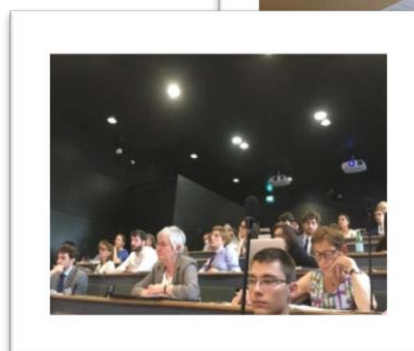
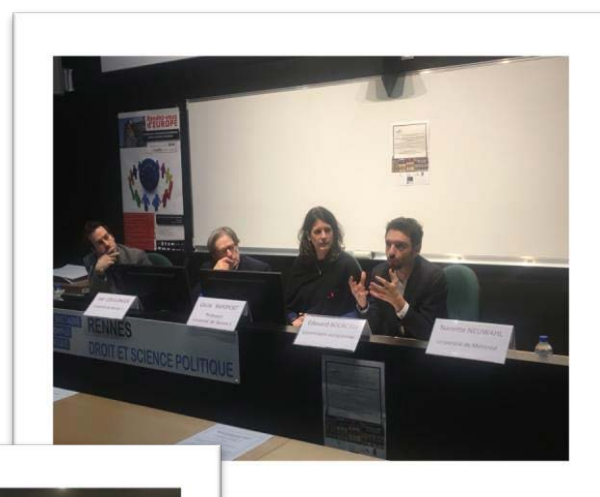
